Presentation Safety Guidelines - Dos and Don'ts

- All participants must remain at least 6 feet away from the reptile handler at all times.
- Loud noises, sudden movements, and shouting are strictly prohibited during the presentation.
- Please do not touch or attempt to handle any reptiles unless given direct permission.
- Food and drinks are not allowed near the animal display area.
- Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- Respect the space of the animals - they are living beings and must be treated gently.
- We reserve the right to end the presentation early if animals or people are at risk.
